Hi again. I'm Sean, your host for today's podcast that covers DollarDays' WishList, a special program created for non-profits and charitable causes to receive merchandise donations.

There are some of you learning about the WishList program for the first time. And there are some of you who are familiar with or have your own WishList, and are excited to learn about the new look of the WishList and its new features.

Before I go into the details of the WishList program, I want to tell you why the program exists. One of DollarDays' core values is giving back to the community. If you are a DollarDays Facebook fan or visit the site once in a while, you'll know that DollarDays gives \$5,000 in merchandise away each month to worthy causes that affects communities across the country. DollarDays Founder and CEO, Marc Joseph, likes DollarDays to be known as "the company with a conscience." Marc further endorses this stance with a monthly blog on Huffington Post that addresses the same types of issues—from pet welfare to homelessness to education support, and more.

Now, back to the topic at hand. How does the WishList work? DollarDays sets up a "Wish List" ecommerce website for your charitable organization. Then your organization selects what items they need for their organization or current mission. DollarDays puts these items on your Wish List website. You can change the products anytime, depending upon you current needs. You will receive your own domain name where donors can go to and purchase the items to donate to your organization. The items are shipped directly to you and the donors receive a receipt for their taxes. This program is completely free.

We have found that it's an easy way for people to contribute and ultimately, they feel good about doing it. They know that buying items wholesale stretches their donation dollars.

You can promote your WishList on your website, newsletters, email signatures, through word of mouth and anywhere you can think of to spread the word. DollarDays offers an online WishList Tool Kit to help you promote your WishList. The ToolKit contains banners, flyers, letters, press releases, tips and more. You simply download the kit and use what you need!

You're wondering about the cost of the program, right? No cost. The WishList Program is a free service from DollarDays. We build the website and ship all the orders to your door. You can see a WishList with our new design at https://www.dollardays.com/achildscry/wishlist.html

Let's talk about our WishList improvements. If you haven't seen the old design, then you won't have anything to compare it with. Those of you in the audience who have seen the old version can attest that the new look is fresh, clean and easy to navigate. We now offer specialized backgrounds that make your WishList draw a little more attention.

We've also added social media buttons so donors and visitors can share your WishList with their social media circles.

Another welcome change is that we have reduced the price of shipping. Shipping on all orders under \$100 is \$6.95, orders over \$100 will be 9.95 and all orders over \$399 will receive free shipping!

The WishList might just be our best kept secret, although we do have a few famous WishLists such as running back football star Ray Rice's charities and the hit Animal Planet show, Pit Bulls and Parolees, which is funded solely by donations. We invite anyone and everyone who has a charitable mission, from a church to a Girl Scout troop to a homeless shelter and everything in between.

Teachers have WishLists to get the supplies they need for their classrooms. Young kids who are passionate about a cause often get a WishList with the guidance of their parents or an adult----a super way to show kids responsibility and that helping others is a gift that helps the hearts of many, including themselves. Families who have lost a loved one to a disease or preventable incident, often have WishLists to help donate to help the cause or cure. The possibilities are limitless. What is your cause or passion and is a WishList right for you??
